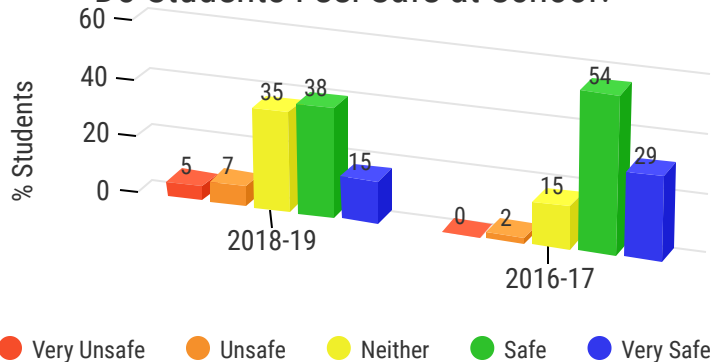

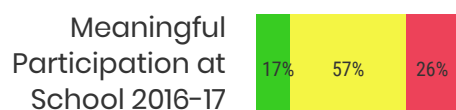
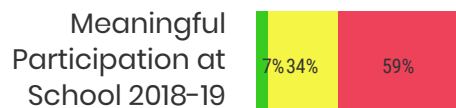
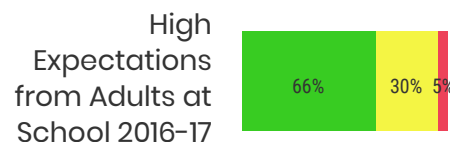
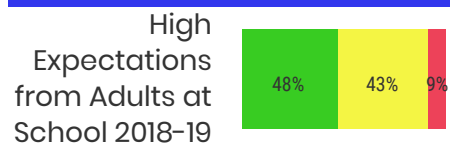
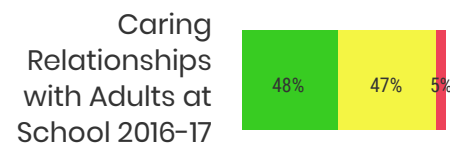
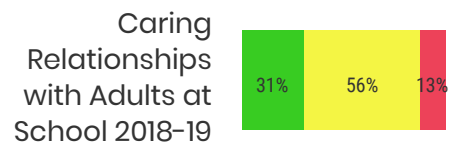
School Engagement

- 53% say this is very much or pretty much true: an adult at school really cares about them
- 67% say this is very much or pretty much true: told when they do a good job from an adult at school
- 60% feel students are treated fairly by teachers at school all or most of the time

Bullying & Alcohol/Drug/Tobacco Use

- 31% report being cyber bullied at least once in the past year
- 10% report using alcohol, marijuana, or other drugs within the previous 30 days
- 5% of students claim to have used tobacco in the past 30 days

Violence, Harrassment, & Victimization

- 32% report being pushed, shoved, slapped, hit, or kicked at school in the past year, not during play
- 43% have had mean rumors or lies spread about them at school in the previous 12 months
- 14% report being offered, sold, or given an illegal drug on school property in the previous 12 months
- 16% claim to have seen someone carrying a weapon on school property in the past 12 months

Engaged Living & Problem Solving

- In the previous month, 47% said they felt unimportant at some level
- In the previous 12 months, 35% of students felt chronically sad or hopeless and 19% seriously considered attempting suicide
- 76% claim there is purpose to their life, at least somewhat
- 69% expect more good things to happen to them than bad
- 82% claim to try hard to make sure they are good at schoolwork
